1. Earth Cycle of Resources

It is designed as a household activity. Instead of a group of students, surveys can be done individually and the results discussed online with colleagues.

Activities can be implemented at home. Students can take an approach to observe littering through their window. They can discuss results in the group. They can also discuss if in regular time when people are not lockdown in their houses would be more litter on the streets. They can focus on writing an article based on discussion online.
