Main tasks and responsibilities

- Conduct research on global educational trends based on online resources and resources provided by National Operators in different YRE countries, and prepare a report about how the YRE programme can fit into global trends and how it can be integrated into national curricula
- Create educational material on YRE programme for teachers, including the information about how the programme can be run through different school subjects
 - Material should be based on national curriculum standards from approximately
 5-10 countries.
 - Material should be related and linked to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
 - Material should include examples of lesson plans together with cases from YRE countries where the YRE programme is already being run through school curricula
- Assist with administrative work for YRE programme when required

Terms and conditions

- Internship for a duration of a minimum of six months
- The successful applicant should start ideally at the beginning of September 2016
- The successful applicant will be provided with a work space at FEE Head Office
- The successful applicant will be responsible for own accommodation and transport between home and FEE Head Office
- English is the official language at FEE Head Office

• The successful applicant may have to travel in Europe in connection with the research

Note: The conditions are negotiable once you have been chosen for the position.

- Good knowledge of written and spoken English
- Background in pedagogical education, communication, environmental study, or policy studies
- Precise and organised way of working
- Proficient user of Microsoft Office package
- Capability of working in a team as well as independently
- Comfortable working in a multicultural environment

- Experience in internship at NGOs
- Fluency in other languages
